NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*
- 1.2** No National prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3** If there is a conflict between language the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.
- 2.2** The following parts of the hull, spars and sails must be kept clear for Organising Authority supplied advertising:
 - hull forward of the shrouds
 - Mainsail below the bottom batten
 - Aft half of the boom
- 2.3** No advertising may be placed in the top panel of the mainsail as this may be needed for flight identification stickers

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the RS Tera class.
- 3.2** Eligible boats may enter at www.rseuropeans.com
- 3.3** Entry Fee: before July, 1st 2009 = €. 125.00
after July, 2nd 2009 = €. 150.00

- 3.4** Competitor entered before the 1st of June 2009 will also receive a free rash vest (please state the requested size on the entry form).

4. FLEETS

3 fleets will be raced

Pro Sail Fleet – (max. age 18 on 2nd August 2009)

Sport Sail Fleet – max age 15 on 2nd August 2009)

Fun Fleet – (using sport sails under 12 on 2nd August 2009)

5. SCHEDULE (Provisional)

- 5.1** Sunday 2nd: Registration
h. 14:00 Practice Race
h. 18:00 Opening ceremony
- Monday 3rd: Races
- Tuesday 4th: Races
- Wednesday 5th: Races
- Thursday 6th: Races (last day)
20.00 Prize giving ceremony

- 5.2** A maximum number of 8 races will be sailed.

- 5.3** A maximum of 3 races per day will be sailed.

- 5.4** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 13:00 on Monday 3rd. For Tuesday 4th to Thursday 6th day earliest start time is 8:30.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 10:00 hrs on the 1st August 2009 at the Yacht Club Acquafresca Race Office.

7. VENUE

Attachment A shows the location of the regatta harbour and how to reach it.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1** Appendix P – Special procedures for Rule 42 will apply.

9. SCORING

- 9.1** The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply.

10. SUPPORT BOATS

- 10.1** Support boats shall register at the Race Office and shall present all the ship's papers required for navigation: rib's engine registration document (engine brand name and serial numbers), rib's engine insurance, driver's identity document. They shall also have onboard a VHF radio set and safety equipment.

- 10.2** Support boats so equipped and registered will be provided with an Identification marking and a flag to be kept both conspicuously displayed together with their national flag or letters during the whole event.

11. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

1 st - 5 th	Pro sail fleet
1 st - 5 th	Sport sail fleet
1 st - 3 rd	Female in Pro sail fleet
1 st - 3 rd	Female in Sport sail fleet

Title will be awarded as follows:

- RS Tera European Pro Sail Champion
- RS Tera European Sport Sail Champion

13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13.2 By launching competitors declare that they are fit and able to stand the present weather conditions. The fact that the Race Committee will provide rescue boats will not remove from competitors the responsibility they have accepted by participating to the race.

13.3 Each competitor is individually responsible for wearing a personal flotation device adequate for the conditions. This floatation device shall be worn each time when afloat. Drysuits or similar equipment will not be considered an adequate personal flotation device.

14. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,000,000.00 EUROS per event or the equivalent. The insurance certificate shall be presented at the registration.

By entering this event competitors agree that the Organising Authority and the RS Feva Class Associations shall have the right to use any images and sound recorded during the event free of charge.

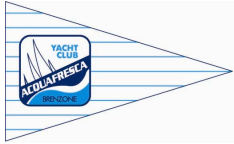

ATTACHMENT A

The Club is località Acquafresca, between Porto and Assenza, in the Comune of Brenzone. You will find a big sporting center.

In the club we have also toilets, dressing room, parking, restaurant.

Coming from north:

follow the Brennero highway, exit Rovereto-Lago di Garda Nord, then to Torbole: take the main street in direction Garda-Verona, pass through Malcesine and reach the villages of Assenza; the club is on the right side, just along the beach, 500 meters after the village.

Coming from south:

follow the Brennero highway, exit Affi-Lago di Garda; follow the signal direction Garda, then take the main road along the lake in direction Malcesine. You will find the villages Torri, Pai, Castelletto and Magagnano di Brenzone; follow the main street until the small village of Porto: the club is on the left side of the road, just along the beach, 500 meters after the village.
